## **Dual Language Bill Awaiting Signature**

The McDonald community has been advocating for dual language. We are so excited to share that we are expecting the dual and tribal language bill HB 1228. It is awaiting Governor Inslee's signature.



Brief summary of the bill:

- Establishes, subject to appropriation, grant programs for establishing or expanding dual language education programs and tribal language education programs.
- Requires provision of literacy supports in service of American Indian and Alaska Native students.
- Makes changes to requirements related to the seal of biliteracy and the Transitional Bilingual Instruction Program.
- · Requires reports from the Office of the Superintendent of

Public Instruction, the Professional Educator Standards Board, and the Paraeducator Board on specified topics.

## Join the McDonald LET ME RUN Team


